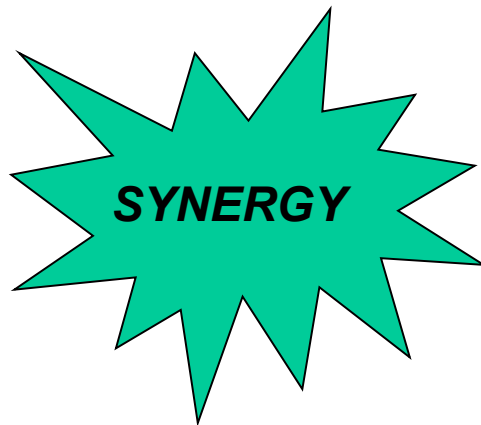

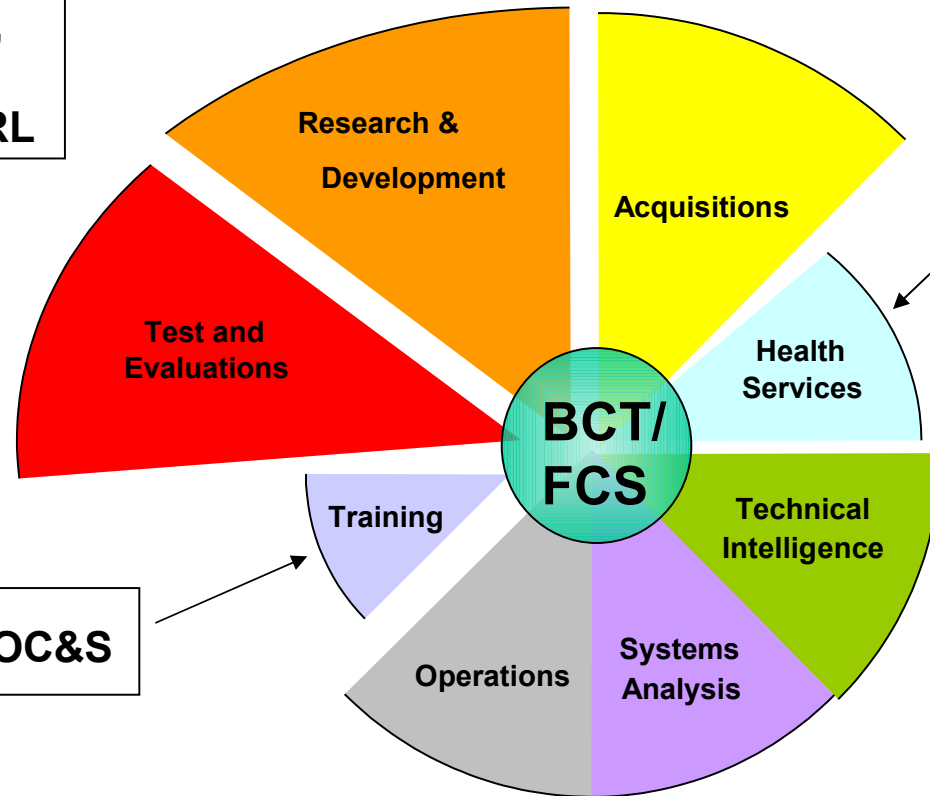

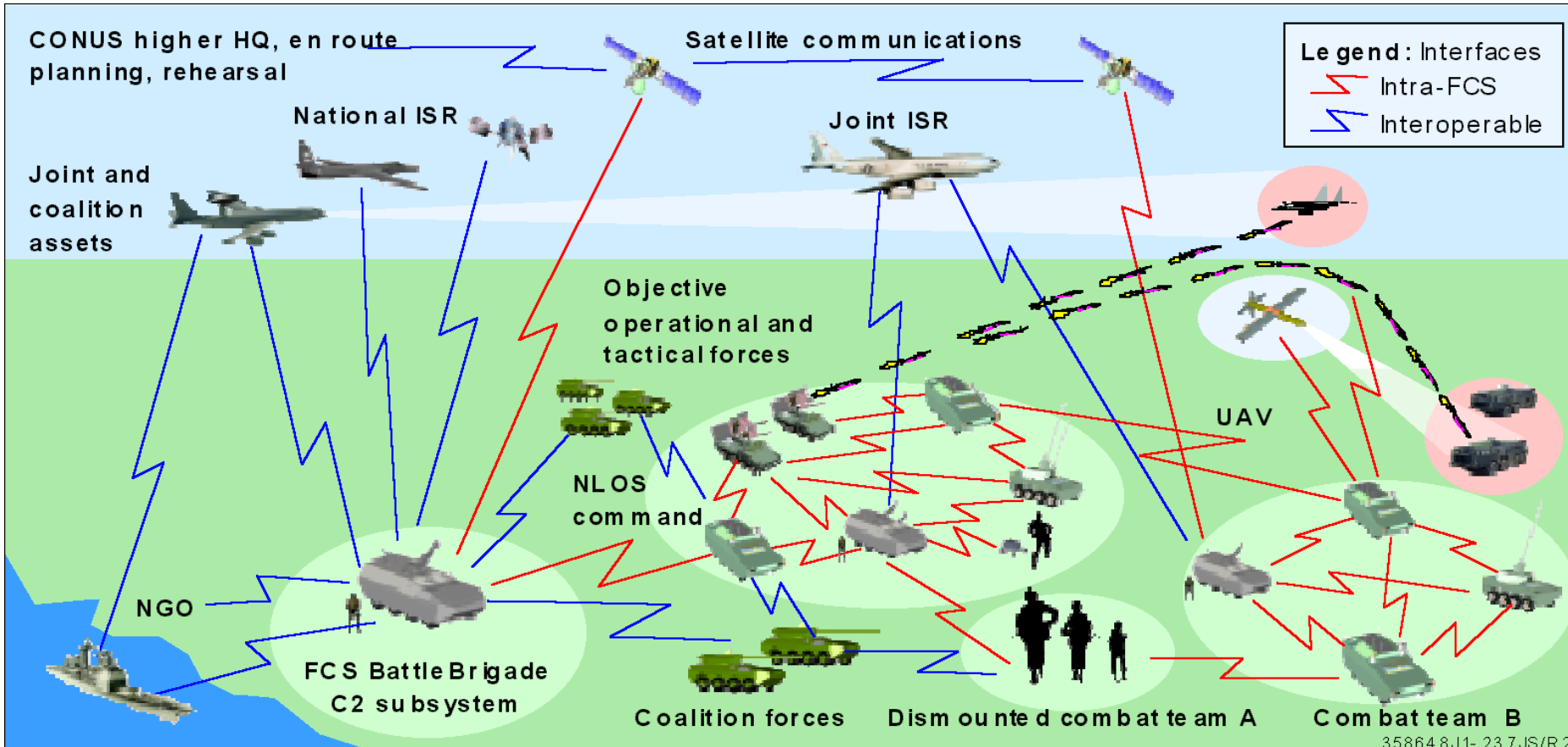

# APG BRAC Effects



- Fewer Military
- Less Transient
- Higher Median Income
- Live in the Communities

- **APG Population:**
  - ~8200 new positions at APG (equates to ~ 54K population growth in community)
  - ~ 4400 net personnel gain (1200-1800 military)
  - ~ 22K new APG total workforce (~5K-10K additional estimated after Enhanced Use Lease buildout)
- **Installation Family Housing:**
  - Current = 1,025 units; fewer than 500 occupied
  - Post BRAC & Residential Communities Initiative =
    - Divest 700+ / Retain 300+ & Close mobile home park
    - Privatization slated for FY09
- **Mission (Technical) Facilities - Current Space Re-Builds/New Builds:**
  - RDT&E administrative/specialty space = ~ 1.5M sq ft
  - Laboratory = ~ 1.3M sq ft

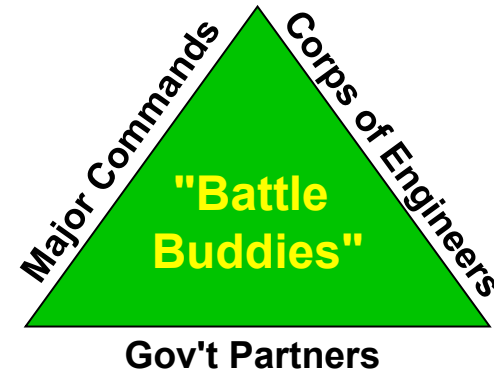

## FUNDING UPDATE

### *On 14 Jun 07, Senator Mikulski Announces Military Construction Spending Bill for APG\**

- \$141M in BRAC funding for Command, Control, Communications, Computers, Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance (C4ISR) facilities
- \$104M in BRAC funding for C4ISR facilities to support the Intelligence and Information Warfare Directorate
- \$27M in BRAC funding the Medical Research Lab for Chem-Bio Defense
- \$2.9M in BRAC funding for the Army Research Lab

**\* Spending bill cleared Senate Appropriations Committee.  
Next step Senate floor for vote.**
